

### LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

Form-Fit™ motorcycle covers are warranted for life to the original purchaser. Warranty coverage protects against defects in material and workmanship as well as the fabric becoming unserviceable during normal use. After factory inspection, We will repair or replace the cover **or** specific panels judged to be unusable. Warranty **does not** cover fading, which occurs naturally on any products used outdoors. This fabric is breathable to allow moisture, condensation and heat to escape from under the fabric.



## Use and Care Instructions

Your new Form-Fit® indoor cover is manufactured with a polyester knit fabric that has spandex in the yarns to allow the cover to stretch and follow the contours of the vehicle. The addition of spandex helps the fabric retain its original memory so the cover doesn't get "baggy" after extended use. The material is breathable and soft against any fine paint finish. It's light weight, easy to handle, and compact to take up minimal storage space. Best of all, it can be easily cleaned in most home washing machines and dryers.



### INSTALLATION

Installation of cover is easiest if you drape the cover over the windscreen or handlebars and then place the cover over the front tire. Then pull the cover towards the rear of the bike and place it around the rear tire. To remove the cover, fold each side up and lay it on top of the bike. Then fold it in sections, or roll it, from the rear forward to the front. Next time you install the cover you will be able to place the bundle in the handlebar/windscreen area and complete the installation as noted above. Use care in installing the cover on a motorcycle which has just been ridden, to be sure any hot exhaust pipes are given adequate time to cool

The elastic at each end of the cover will keep it in place under all normal conditions.

### STORAGE BAG

Your new cover is supplied complete with a storage bag. After removing the cover from the vehicle, place it inside the storage bag if the cover will not be used for a period of time.


**NOTE - Form-Fit covers are not designed for use when towing. Serious damage can occur to the cover and the paint surface of the bike may also be damaged. If you use a cover for towing you do so at your own risk.**

Many antennas can be folded flat by pulling them up at the base to release the locking mechanism. If your bike has radio antennas which will not fold flat you will have to provide openings in the cover. We have included two (2) non-corrosive plastic grommet sets for the antenna openings.

1) The most accurate way to make an antenna opening is to remove the antenna and install the cover on the bike, making sure it is properly aligned and positioned. Using a sharp pencil, punch a hole through the fabric at the antenna location. Be careful to avoid hitting the finish with the pencil. If the antenna is not easily removed, see procedure #2.

2) Place the cover on the bike and roll or fold the cover as close to the antenna as possible. Center the cover on the bike, align the seams from front to rear and be sure the cover is pulled down evenly over the front tire. Position the cover next to the base of the antenna. Recheck the overall positioning of the cover to make sure it has not moved on the bike. Mark the cover with the location of the antenna base and make a hole with a sharp pencil.

Use sharp scissors to make the hole opening 3/4 inch in diameter and install the grommet as shown in the diagram to the right. The outside grommet ring fit is very tight. Place the cover on a CLEAN hard surface, position the the inside grommet through the opening you made and then secure the outside grommet snap-ring in place using a rubber mallet. Do **NOT** use excessive force or the ring can be damaged. Do **NOT** install the grommet with the cover on the bike.



### **IMPORTANT WARNINGS - PLEASE READ BEFORE USING COVER!**

**OUTDOOR USE OF THIS COVER:** Form-Fit covers were designed for INDOOR storage use. The fabric color was not designed to be UV resistant and will fade over time when exposed to sunlight.

**HAZING OF WINDOWS AND PAINT:** Airborne pollutants may be deposited on the windshield or paint while a bike is being ridden or when parked uncovered. These deposits may become smeared and create a haze when the cover is used. The haze can be wiped off with a damp cloth or washed off with water.

**WARNING TO OWNERS OF REPAINTED BIKES:** Use of a cover on any recently painted surface may cause damage to that surface! If your bike has been repainted, check with the painter on the specifics of how and when you can use this cover

**PERSONALIZED MARKING INSTRUCTIONS:** The application of large letters and/or numbers on the side or front of the cover showing the bike's license plate or name(s) is one of the best methods for protecting your cover against theft. If you choose to put identification markings on your cover please note the following:

- DO NOT use regular or spray paint!
- DO NOT use laundry markers or "permanent" type Magic markers.
- DO NOT use any type of felt-tip pen or marker.

The only type of marking paint that is acceptable for use on this material is a permanent type fabric/T-shirt paint. This paint is readily available in a variety of colors at most fabric and art supply stores. Follow the manufacturer's instructions. Use a single coating of the fabric paint for marking the outside of the cover with your personalized markings.

**WARNING** - Markers and regular paint will not adhere to the fabric and can transfer their color onto the vehicle finish.

### **CLEANING AND WASHING INSTRUCTIONS**

Any cover will slowly collect dust on its underside, picked up from contact with the surface of the bike. Your Form-Fit cover may be washed using most any home-type washing machine and dryer. Most are large enough to accommodate this cover. NOTE - Large size covers will be easier to clean if washed and dried in commercial, over-sized washers and dryers.

NEVER...Use fabric softener.

- 1 - Wash the cover using 1/4 cup of Simple Green All-Purpose Cleaner. Put the cover in the washer and pour the cleaner in the tub after it's filled with warm water or, for some wall mounted commercial units pour it directly in the machine, then put in the cover and start the machine. Use a "gentle" cycle if available.
- 2 - Rinse the cover twice (2X) to remove all the cleaner.
- 3 - Air dry, or use a dryer set on Permanent Press heat setting.
